Speaker: Dr Alpana Roy
Dr Alpana Roy is a barrister, mediator, and lecturer in law at UTS. Prior to commencing practice at the NSW Bar, she worked as a solicitor for a number of years in both the private and public spheres, and has practiced as a lawyer internationally. In Sydney she has worked for *Clayton Utz*, *Mallesons Stephen Jaques*, and also as a government lawyer. She has several years of experience in academia, where she has lectured in a wide range of postgraduate and undergraduate intellectual property subjects. Prior to her current position at UTS, she previously lectured at the University of Sydney where she obtained both her law degree and her PhD in intellectual property law. Alpana is currently in the process of writing a text in IP for Thomson Lawbook. She is widely published in IP, and is a commissioned author for several major legal publishers, including Thomson Lawbook, LexisNexis Butterworths, CCH, and the Oxford University Press. She is regularly invited to speak at seminars on a wide range of intellectual property topics. Apart from her PhD, she also has degrees in law, social science, and postgraduate qualifications in higher education and journalism.
