Michael Blakeney is Professor of Law at the University of Western Australia and Herchel Smith Professor of Intellectual Property Law at Queen Mary, University of London He formerly worked in the Asia Pacific Bureau of the World Intellectual Property Organization and is an arbitrator with the International Court of Arbitration. Professor Blakeney has advised the Asian Development Bank, Consulting Group for International Agricultural Research, European Commission (EC), European Patent Office, Food and Agricultural Organization, World Intellectual Property Organization and a number of university and public research institutes on intellectual property management. He has directed EC projects concerned with the establishment of an IP infrastructure in a number of new EU Member States and EU Applicant States and is currently managing a project for the Commonwealth Secretariat to co-ordinate IP enforcement within the Commonwealth.

His most recent books are: Trade Related Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights. A Concise Guide to the TRIPs Agreement London: Sweet & Maxwell, 1996; Intellectual Property Aspects of Ethnobiology (Editor) London: Sweet & Maxwell, 1999; Border Control of Intellectual Property Rights (Editor), London: Sweet & Maxwell 2001; IP in Biodiversity and Agriculture: Regulating the Biosphere (Editor with P. Drahos), London: Sweet & Maxwell 2001; Enforcement Handbook, Brussels: EC, 2003, International Encyclopaedia of Intellectual Property Treaties (with A.
