Topic: **Joint Liability in IP Disputes: Common Design and Conspiracy**

Commercial or strategic reasons may require a Claimant to consider alleging liability of more than one Defendant in any commercial litigation. This webinar will focus on two routes by which joint liability might be established in IP disputes:

- liability of a second Defendant on account of a common design with the first; and
- liability of all Defendants for conspiracy to injure the Claimant by unlawful means.

During the webinar, the speakers will address similarities of, and differences between, the two routes, especially those relating to:

- the elements of each, including intention;
- the extent of the joint liability for the alleged IP infringement(s); and
- the application of jurisdictional rules.

John is a solicitor advocate with a Natural Sciences degree from the University of Cambridge.
